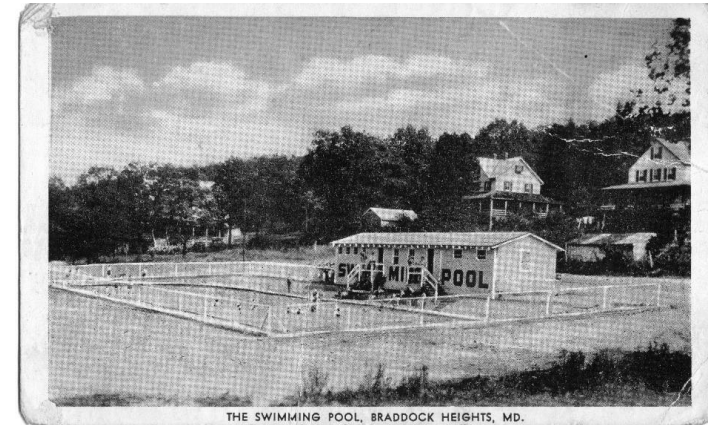

Frequently Asked Questions:

Why do I have to pay an initiation fee?

The Braddock Heights Community Pool is a nonprofit organization managed by the Braddock Heights Community Association for the benefit of the community. Each pool member is required to pay the initiation fee in order to join. While membership fees are used to run the pool each summer, initiation fees are put solely toward funding pool improvements such as paving, landscaping, pool furniture and equipment.

My children are all 5 and under - does it make sense for us to join?

Yes - we have many families with young children! We have a wonderful, generously sized (30'x30') baby pool that is reserved exclusively for young children and their parents. Graded from 4"- 22" deep, this pool is a great place to play safely with toys, friends and family. Children 5 and under are also allowed in the big pool with their parents during adult swim times, for an easy introduction to swimming without the big kid splashing!

My spouse and I both work. Can we still get our money's worth for the summer?

Absolutely! Many families come to the pool after dinner, or meet each other there for a picnic supper.

We have extended family in the area, can we add them to our membership?

Daily guest passes are available for these family members. Pool membership, however, is limited to only those family members who reside in the same household as the primary membership adult.
